what, who, when, & where

- a** **The Kaufmann House:** Architect Richard Neutra | Built 1946 | Noted example of the International Style of architecture | 470 W Vista Chino
- b** **Frank Sinatra House:** Architect E. Stewart Williams | Built 1946 | 1148 Alejo Road
- c** **Del Marcos Hotel:** Architect William Cody | Built 1947 | 225 W Baristo Road
- d** **Ocotillo Lodge:** Architect William Krisel | Built 1956 | 1111 E Palm Canyon Dr. | Originally a hotel, it is now a condominium complex.
- e** **Bob Hope House:** Architect John Lautner | Built 1961 | Top of Southridge Drive (private) | The mushroom-shaped house atop the hill.
- f** **Royal Hawaiian Estates:** Architects Don Wexler and William Harrison | Built 1961-1962 | 1962-1780 S Palm Canyon Drive | Integrating Polynesian design into the mid-century aesthetic.
- g** **Alexander Steel Houses:** Architect Donald Wexler | Built 1962 | 300 & 330 E. Molino Road | Seven homes were built before the project was scrapped because of the rising cost of steel.
- h** **House of Tomorrow:** Architect William Krisel | Built 1962 | 1350 Ladera Circle | Concept design that the Krisel's ultimately made their Palm Springs residence. Years later it was used by Elvis and Priscilla Presley as their honeymoon retreat.
- i** **Frey House II:** Architect Albert Frey | Built 1963 | 686 W Palisades Drive | Built into the mountain side, it blends indoor and outdoor spaces.
- j** **Sunnylands (the former Annenburg Estate):** Architect A. Quincy Jones | Built 1963 | Tours 760-328-2829 | 37977 Bob Hope Drive, Rancho Mirage | Guests to this estate have included many past Presidents.
